Important Note: If your account is in respect of a “multi-unit complex”, and you were receiving the 8% Provincial Rebate on your electricity bill on October 22, 2019, but you are ineligible for the Ontario Provincial Rebate under the new rules, you will continue to receive a rebate, in the amount of 31.8%, until October 31, 2020, provided you submit this form by February 1, 2020. If the form is not received by February 1, 2020, you will stop receiving the rebate on January 31, 2020.
